

SEND questionnaire results 2019 - 20

8 questionnaires were sent out with 4 returned which gives a 50% return rate. 3 children had EHCP's and 1 child has Inclusion Support Early year funding. All 4 of these children had Inclusion Support Assistants.

Questions 25% = 1 parent

- 1) I feel that my child is making good progress at school **100% agree**
Progress for his personal ability over the last 2 years.
- 2) I know how my child is supported in school **100% agree**
- 3) I am concerned that my child is not getting enough support **100% disagree**
My child has 1 to 1 support in Nursery. There is support from the Key worker and the SENCO.
- 4) I feel that I have sufficient information and communication about my child's progress **100% agree**
- 5) I know which stage of the SEN Code of Practice my child is on
100% agree
- 6) I have had opportunities to share my child's targets with their key worker
100% agree
I have daily open communication with the staff.
- 7) I understand my child's targets
100% agree
- 8) I am fully aware of how my child is progressing towards their targets
100% agree
- 9) I feel that Selly Oak Nursery staff have given me suggestions of ways to support my child at home
100% agree
- 10) I know who the SENCO (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator) is at Selly Oak Nursery School **100% agree**
I know who the SENCO is and the Behaviour Co-ordinator.

11) I am able to approach the staff about any concerns that I have regarding my child
100% agree
All staff are very approachable.

Other comments:

- The support my daughter has been given has been excellent. Thank you to all.
- Maybe a sheet at the start with basic information on, e.g. SENCO's name, names of agencies involved in Nursery and their role.

Next steps
