

SEND questionnaire results 2017 - 18

5 questionnaires were sent out with 3 returned which gives a 60% return rate. All 5 children have been referred to a Paediatrician or EP assessment during the year. 1 child had an EHCP finalised. 1 child received CRISP funding during the whole year. 1 child received ISEY during the autumn and spring terms, followed by CRISP funding in the summer term. 2 children had EHCP targets and 3 children had an SEN and Early Years Support Plan

Questions 33% = 1 parent

- 1) I feel that my child is making good progress at school 100% agree

- 5) I know which stage of the SEN Code of Practice my child is on

- 6) I have had opportunities to share my child's targets with their key worker

- 7) I understand my child's targets

- 8) I am fully aware of how my child is progressing towards their targets
100% agree
- 9) I feel that Selly Oak Nursery staff have given me suggestions of ways to support my child at home
100% agree
- 10) I know who the SENCO (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator) is at Selly Oak Nursery School 100% agree

11) I am able to approach the staff about any concerns that I have regarding my child
100% agree
